They will use colour mixing techniques and use a range of materials with care. Children will be encouraged to notice features of the natural world and define colours, shapes, textures and smells. They will learn how to use adhesive tape and different types of glue to join and construct They will discuss and reflect on their outcomes. | | |
| Year 1 | <p>Drawing (Self-portraits)</p> <p>Children will use a range of materials and artistic techniques to consider line, shape, form and space to create a self-portrait.</p> | <p>Painting and printing (Wassily Kandinsky)</p> <p>Children will mix colours and explore printmaking using a range of materials to create a Kandinsky inspired piece.</p> | <p>Sculpture/Collage (Natural Materials)</p> <p>Children will use natural materials to consider pattern, texture and shape and create their own 3D pictures and models.</p> |
| Year 2 | <p>Textiles/Collage (Craft weaving)</p> <p>Children will use weaving tools to weave a range of materials and develop different overlapping effects.</p> | <p>Drawing (Digital - Pablo Picasso)</p> <p>Children will continue to investigate light and dark tones using a pencil and create a digital version of their design using draw, shape, fill and crop tools.</p> | <p>Painting (Van Gogh)</p> <p>Children will mix and choose colours for a specific effect and re-create a famous Van Gogh painting using similar artistic techniques.</p> |
| Year 3 | <p>Drawing/Painting (Cave Art)</p> <p>Children will use their line, tone, form and shading skills to record sketches using a range of media</p> | <p>Printing (Relief Printing)</p> <p>Children will use a range of materials and media to explore printing and create their</p> | <p>Sculpture (Relief Sculpture)</p> <p>Children will use moulding and carving skills to create a relief sculpture using overlapping clay tiles.</p> |

| Year 4 | <p>Painting (Digital - Andy Warhol)</p> <p>Children will explore Andy Warhol's blotted line technique and create a digital pop art inspired image.</p> | <p>Collage (Mosaics)</p> <p>Children will produce surface patterns using a range of materials with varying colour and textures to create a mosaic tile.</p> | <p>Textiles (Applique)</p> <p>Children will explore different types of stitching and modify fabric to produce a decorative piece.</p> |
| Year 5 | <p>Drawing/Painting (Silhouettes)</p> <p>Children will develop their fine brush strokes, use tonal contrast and mixed media to create Silhouettes.</p> | <p>Printing (Mayan Prints)</p> <p>Children will blend two or more colours together and print on fabric. They will experiment using lino and carving tools to create their prints.</p> | <p>Sculpture (Clay Pots)</p> <p>Children will use pinching, slabbing, carving and coiling to produce a clay pot and will explore different finishing techniques such as glaze, paint and polish.</p> |
| Year 6 | <p>Drawing (Landscapes)</p> <p>Children will develop perspective in their drawings using a range of media to produce a landscape drawing.</p> | <p>Textiles/Collage (Applique and Embroidery)</p> <p>Children will explore more complex styles of stitching and use embroidery to add decoration to fabric.</p> | <p>Painting (Claude Monet)</p> <p>Children will study impressionism and experiment with change of lighting using a range of media. They will re-create a Monet piece using similar artistic techniques.</p> |
